The Junior category witnessed a remarkable display of talent, with Garcia Kimemia emerging as the champion. Playing off a handicap of 18, Kimemia's score of 28 Nett Points were enough to earn him the bragging rights among the juniors.

In other results, Ndegwa Thuku claimed the Longest Drive title in the Men's category, while Lucy Maina emerged victorious among the ladies. At the same time, Gibson Singen showcased remarkable precision, securing the Nearest to the Pin title.
