Sissel Rene, playing off handicap of 29, clinched the Overall Nett category title among the ladies with an impressive score of 64 nett.

Meanwhile, the junior category witnessed a remarkable display of talent, with Pari Maisuria emerging as the champion. Playing off a handicap of 27, Maisuria's score of 104 gross was sufficient to earn him the bragging rights among the juniors.
