NCBA GOLF SERIES HEADS TO KAKAMEGA SPORTS CLUB

Nairobi: Thursday, 8th June 2023: Kakamega Sports Club is set to play host to the 2023 NCBA Golf Series this Saturday, 10th June 2023. The fifth edition of the series will witness the participation of at least 100 golfers from Kakamega and neighbouring clubs, including Nyanza Golf Club.

The golfers will compete for coveted slots in the Grand Finale, which is scheduled to take place later this year. The winners of the overall gross, Men's category, Women's category, and Juniors category will earn their place to compete in the Grand Finale.

The event follows the successful fourth leg held on May 25th at Thika Sports Club, which attracted an impressive field of 256 golfers. David Matano emerged as the overall winner, triumphing over a strong field of competitors. Simon Ndung'u secured victory in the Men's category, while Naomi Kimata claimed the title of top Lady golfer. Garcia Kimemia emerged as the champion among the juniors. These four outstanding golfers earned their qualification for the series' grand finale scheduled for December.

The NCBA Golf Series not only seeks to promote the sport of golf throughout the East African region but also aims to foster a stronger connection between NCBA Bank and its customers through their shared love for the game.
