

## NCBA GOLF SERIES 2024 TERMS OF COMPETITION

1. Format: The format of play shall be Stableford. All players must be registered and have a valid World Handicapping System CDH ID. Each player is expected to play off the correct handicap index at the start of play.
2. The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules and the Local rules printed at the back of each clubs' scorecard.
3. The 2024 NCBA Golf Series is open to the hosting club members and invited NCBA partners and stakeholders.
4. Competition entries shall be received no later than 5pm on the Tuesday preceding the Saturday event to ensure the draw is well prepared and shared.
5. All players will be expected to pay their entry fee at their respective club's Golf office before play.
6. Competition entry fee will be determined by the competition committee of the different hosting clubs in accordance with club rules.
7. Slow players will be expected to give way to the groups behind.
8. Starting time: Play will commence at the time laid down by the competition committee with players expected to report to their respective starter 10 minutes before their tee time. The starter's time is deemed to denote the correct tournament time.
9. In the event of adverse weather conditions necessitating discontinue of play, the club Competition committee will decide on the result.
10. In the event of a tie, the winning score will be decided on countback.
11. The top **10** prize categories will be as follows:
  - **Division 1 – (up to Handicap 12)**  
4 Winners (Men Winner and Runner-Up plus Lady Winner and Runner-Up)
  - **Division 2 – (Hcp 13 - 24)**  
2 Winners (Men & Lady Winner)
  - **Division 3 – (Hcp 25 and above)**  
1 Winner (m/f)
  - Junior Winner (m/f)
  - Guest Winner (m/f)
  - Staff Winner (m/f)
12. The following **6** players from the qualifying Series' shall have qualified to play in the NCBA Golf series 2024 Grand Finale:
  - Division 1 Male Winner and Lady Winner
  - Division 2 Male Winner and Lady Winner
  - Division 3 Overall Winner
  - Overall Junior Winner
13. Prizes shall **NOT** be kept for players who are not in a position to stay for the prize giving ceremony i.e **No Show – No Prize.**
14. The junior golfer category will be open to juniors aged 18 and under.

15. Junior qualifiers shall NOT be eligible to win the Grand Finale overall prize.
16. The participants of the Grand Finale residing in Nairobi will be required to cater for their own logistics to attend the event. Qualifiers from out of Nairobi will get transport and accommodation catered for.
17. The top 3 FINALE winners, that is (**Division 1- Overall Winner, Division 1 – Men Winner, Division 1- Lady Winner**) will each walk away with exciting prizes.
18. The hosting club competition committee will rule on any dispute that may arise and their decision will be final.
19. By registering for the NCBA tournaments you give permission to create and use the images, videos and other digital media consisting of your likeness. The Media may be published on NCBA's channels and platforms.
