At the same time, Carol Nthiwa, playing off a handicap of 23, dominated the Division Two Ladies' category, securing victory with a score of 33 points, beating Damaris Kikwal (handicap 21) who finished second with 32 points.



Col. Henry Mwereneru, playing off a handicap of 50, reigned supreme in Division Three, with a score of 49 points while the Junior category was won by Hakeem Mutungi (handicap 21), who impressed with a score of 28 points.
