

NCBA GOLF SERIES 2025

TERMS OF COMPETITION

- 1. Format: The format of play shall be individual **Stroke play Medal**.
- 2. All players must be registered and have a valid World Handicapping System CDH ID.
- The competition will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules and the Local rules printed at the back of each clubs' scorecard.
- 4. The 2025 NCBA Golf Series is open to hosting club members and invited NCBA partners and stakeholders.
- 5. Competition entries shall be received not later than 5pm on the Tuesday preceding the Saturday event to ensure the draw is well prepared and shared.
- All players will be expected to pay their entry fee at the respective club's Golf office before play.
- Competition entry fee will be determined by the competition committee of the different hosting clubs in accordance with club rules.
- 8. Slow players will be expected to give way to the groups behind.
- Starting time: Play will commence at the time laid down by the competition committee with players expected to report to their respective starters 10 minutes before their tee time. The starter's time is deemed to denote the correct tournament time.
- 10. In the event of adverse weather conditions necessitating discontinue of play, the club competition committee will make a decision on the result.
- 11. In the event of a tie, the winning score will be decided on countback.

12. The prize categories shall be as follows:

- Overall Gross Men Winner
- Overall Gross Lady Winner
- Division I Nett Winner (up to playing handicap 12 m/f)
- Division II Men Nett Winner (playing handicap 13 24)
- Division II Lady Nett Winner (playing handicap 13 24)
- Division III Nett Winner (playing handicap 25 and above m/f)
- Junior Winner
- Guest Winner (m/f)
- Staff Winner (m/f)
- Longest Drive (Men & Lady)
- Nearest to the Pin (Men & Lady)
- 13. Prizes shall NOT be kept for players who are not in a position to stay for the prize giving ceremony.
- 14. The following 6 players from every qualifying competition shall have also qualified to play in the NCBA Golf series 2025 Grand Finale (Overall Men Gross Winner, Overall Lady Gross Winner, Division 2 Men & Lady nett Winner, Division 3 Overall nett Winner, and Junior nett Winner).
- 15. The junior golfer category will be open to juniors aged 18 years and under.
- 16. Junior qualifiers shall NOT be eligible to win the Grand Finale overall prize.
- 17. The participants of the Grand Finale residing in Nairobi will be required to cater for their own logistics to attend the event. Qualifiers from out of Nairobi and residing at least 75 km from Nairobi will get a stipend for their transport and accommodation catered for.

- 18. The hosting club competition committee will rule out any dispute that may arise and their decision will be final.
- 19. By registering for the NCBA tournaments you give permission to create and use the images, videos and other digital media consisting of your likeness. The Media may be published on NCBA's channels and platforms.
